

## **Gift of Jesus**

Create a special gift to be opened by your family Christmas morning. This gift will serve as a reminder of the greatest gift ever received.

## Items needed:

- Shredded wheat biscuit
- Glue
- Disposable bowl
- Plastic spoon
- Baby figure
- Fabric square
- Box
- Wrapping paper
- Tag



Shred the cereal in the bowl. Mix some glue into the shredded wheat with the spoon, and shape the mixture into the form of a manger. Let dry.

Wrap a piece of cloth around the baby like a blanket. Place it in the manger. Put the manger and the baby inside a gift box, and wrap it with Christmas paper. Decorate your gift with a ribbon and/or bow and attach the poem (see next page) to the box.

Place your wrapped gift under the tree. On Christmas morning, unwrap this gift first as a family.
