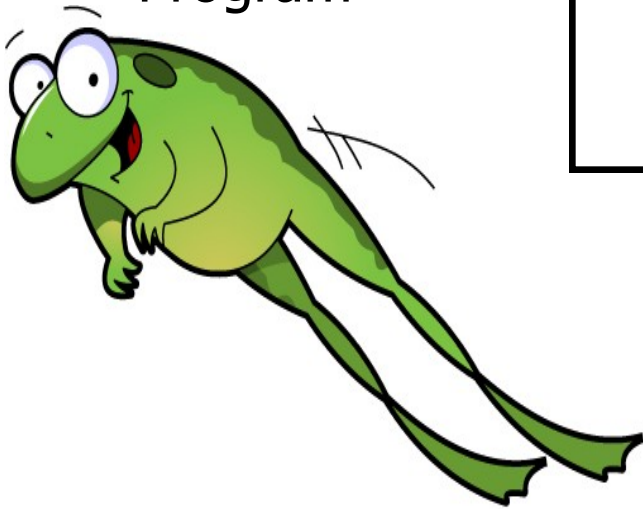

What is LEAP?

St. Peter's Learning Enrichment and Achievement Program (LEAP) is an enrichment program that is offered in the afternoon every preschool day (*Monday through Thursday*) and operates as an extension to the morning preschool session. LEAP provides additional instruction and learning opportunities that are designed to enrich and develop literacy and math skills.

Why LEAP?

St. Peter's LEAP was uniquely designed to allow each child to reach his or her highest potential. We seek an individualized learning program full of hands-on activities designed to develop each child's character, concentration, socialization and work habits in addition to strengthening each student's essential early literacy and math skills.

For whom is this program designed?

This enrichment is designed for ALL 5 and 6 year old children...from those requiring extra instruction and practice on basic literacy and math skills to those who come to us with advanced skills and wish to be challenged.

How does LEAP work?

LEAP is rooted in small group and individualized instruction for students, where the teacher tailors instruction to the students' individual learning styles and skill levels, and the instructional approach ensures that children are taught in such a way that learning is personal, functional, enjoyable and developmentally appropriate. The framework of this program curriculum is unified and integrated through stimulating, creative and fun learning activities.

Where is the LEAP program located?

LEAP afternoons are divided between the day school for lunch and recess, and the preschool in the LEAP room.

How will the transition be made from preschool to LEAP everyday?

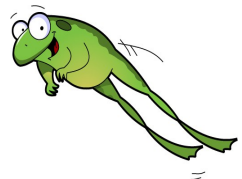
Preschool will end at 11:30. At that time, children will be walked across the street to the day school. LEAP students will join the kindergarten class for lunch. Your child will have the option of bringing his or her own lunch from home or purchasing a sack or hot lunch. The "Enrichment Labs" will be held at preschool for the LEAPsters in the LEAP room.

When can I pick up my child?

School lets out at 3:00pm. You have until 3:10 to pick up your child from preschool. You may go through carline or park in the church lot and enter the preschool to pick up your student. Clubhouse (before and after school childcare) is available until 5:30 everyday for a small fee should you choose to use that service.

How much does LEAP cost?

There is a \$65 materials fee due at registration. The LEAP program itself is \$193 per month. (The additional 5 year old PreK morning preschool program tuition is not included in the \$193)

During this time, students work in small groups as they rotate through a variety of hands-on, interactive literacy and math centers in which they practice, extend and expand upon literacy and math skills taught during teacher directed and/or teacher supported learning activities. Class enrichment centers are specifically designed for multiple student skill levels in order to meet the needs of each child. Students also meet daily with the teacher for skill specific/ student need based small group and individualized instruction.
